They direct urgently needed resources to post-9/11 service members from the Army, Marine Corps, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard and Reserves.

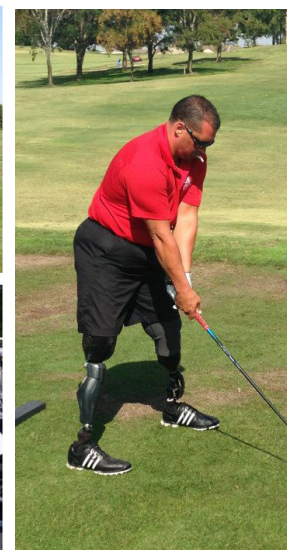
Their streamlined structure keeps overhead as low as possible because they realize every dollar saved can be put to better use serving those who have served us all in the ongoing job of preserving our nation's freedom. Since their inception in May 2004, Semper Fi Fund has issued 130,000

grants, totaling more than \$142 million in assistance to over 17,000 heroes and their families.

The Semper Fi Fund is unique among veteran nonprofits: They pledge to stay by the service member's side throughout his or her recovery, to help that service member as they transition back home, and to provide lifetime support. The Semper Fi Fund has consistently received a **4-star rating from Charity Navigator**, and an **A+ from CharityWatch**, one of only two veteran nonprofits to receive this rating.
